About Group visits to the Almonry

The Almonry is a beautiful fourteenth century building in the heart of Evesham.

Originally part of the Benedictine Abbey, the Almonry is now home to the Town Museum, with themed rooms that tell the story of Evesham from prehistory to the mid-twentieth century and a secluded garden, perfect for relaxing or having a picnic.

Monday-Saturday 10am-5pm

November—February

Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri, Sat 10am-5pm

Please note the Almonry is unable to offer evening group visits. Group visits at weekends are subject to staff availability.

Group Charges

If you would like to book a group visit please complete the booking form opposite. On receipt of the form we will write to you to confirm the date. If the date you have selected is not available we will offer an alternative.

The group booking rate is only available for groups of 10 or more paying visitors and bookings must be made with a least 4 weeks notice. A £10 non-refundable deposit is required to secure the booking.

A guided tour of the Almonry is available for an additional £5.

Charges for group visits

Adult : £4.50 per head

Concessions: £1.80 (over 65, FT student)

Child (under 11): FREE

Full payment will be taken on the day of your visit. Please make all cheques payable to *Evesham Town Council*.

If you are arriving by coach, the coach drop off is on Merstow Green opposite the Almonry, we can provide a map showing town centre car parks if requested.
